We offer 3 postgraduate qualifications in freshwater management

Postgraduate Diploma in Water Resource Management

1 year full-time or 2–3 years part time study (courses).

Master of Water Resource Management

2 years full-time or up to 4 years part time study (courses and a research thesis). A “thesis only” option is available if you have appropriate and relevant postgraduate or work experience.

PhD in Water Resource Management

3–5 year research thesis.



You can enrol in these postgraduate degrees at either the University of Canterbury or Lincoln University.

Entry requirements

- A strong desire to improve the quality, availability and natural function of our freshwaters resources, and ...
- A Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in a field of relevance to freshwater management.*

Start dates

Applications accepted until mid January for Semester 1, and early June for Semester 2.

It is usually better to start your qualification in Semester 1 if you can, as teaching builds on semester 1 courses. Thesis students can begin any time.
